






"Count me out!" says Sara, shaking her head. Her reaction takes me totally by surprise.


"You don't want to enter? But it'll be fun . . ."

My grandma has even stuck a picture of me on the kitchen door to ban me from entering!"






All this makes me feel like a soggy sponge.
